We would like to announce a recent development. Due to popular demand, we have brought back the first show we ever created – *Crossing Mountains: The Hindman Settlement School Story*. Crossing Mountains: The Hindman Settlement School Story was premiered for the centennial of The Hindman Settlement School in 2002. It explores 100 years of education and change in the Kentucky Mountains, exploring the many obstacles against which an Appalachian mountain community in Kentucky has had to struggle in order to create exceptional opportunities for the youth and adults of the region. From its founding as a full time school program in 1902 to its present incarnation of housing The James Still Learning Center for Students with Dyslexia and other Learning Disabilities while also providing a forum for the folk arts and running an Adult Education program, it has succeeded in responding effectively to the needs of the surrounding community for over 100 years. This play explores the school's history, its significance to its specific community and its resonance with the entire human community. At the play's core is the universal struggle for progress and growth.
